We've created an email template for you to send to parents explaining how to do this. This can be found at the end of the document.

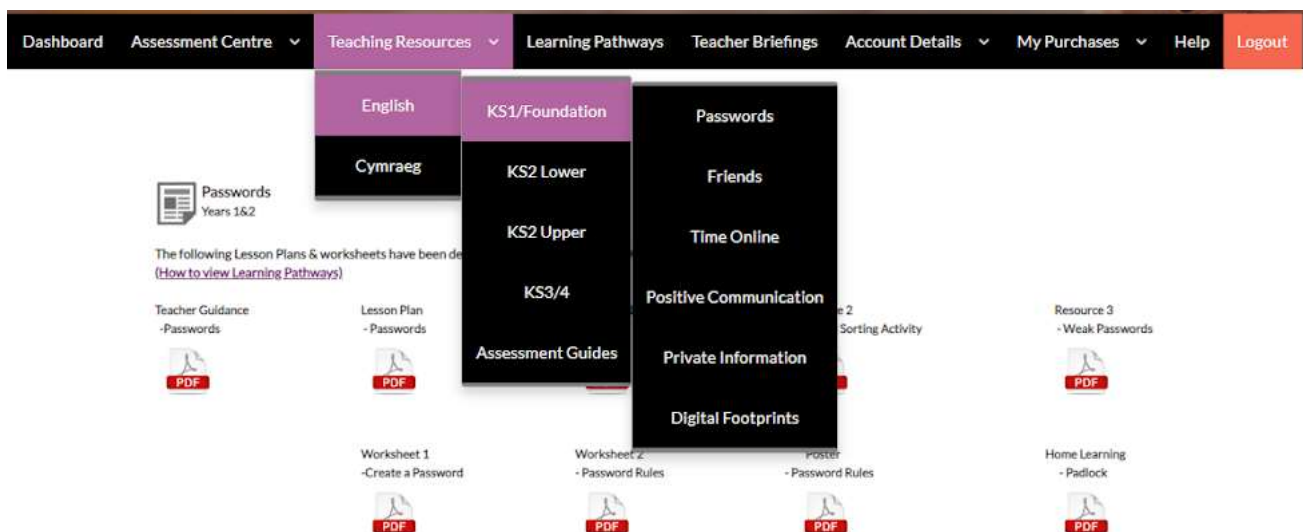
Step 3
